## **SPECIAL RULES**

- 3. Barrows only may be shown in this division. Final class breaks shall be left to the discretion of the Superintendent.
- 4. Minimum weight is 200 lbs. No maximum weight.
- 5. Any coat dressing other than water is prohibited.
- 6. No Swine Clipping will be allowed on the Fairgrounds. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 7. Awards: Buckles and rosettes to Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion.
  Rosettes to Breed Champions and Reserve Breed Champions (Buckles to Breed Champions if sponsored). Ribbons awarded to top six places in each class.
- 8. Junior Livestock Sale: A total of 34 Junior Market Barrows will be eligible for the sale. These will be allocated in proportion to the number entered in each breed with the provision that a minimum of 2 per class will sell.
- 9. Showmanship classes (Novice, Junior and Senior) will follow the Grand Drive. All interested contestants need to enter on-line.
- 10. ALL SWINE WILL BE SELF CLASSIFIED during the online entry process. No official classification will happen during the weigh-in process Tuesday of fair week. However, classifications can be changed at weigh-in by the exhibitor. Once the Superintendent has submitted check in paper work to the livestock office no further changes will be allowed. DURING JUDGING OF THE SHOW, IF THE JUDGE FEELS THE ANIMAL DOES NOT MEET BREED CHARACTERISTICS, IT WILL BE PLACED ACCORDINGLY IN THE CLASS. ANIMALS WILL NOT BE MOVED TO A DIFFERENT CLASS PERIOD.

- 11. Weigh in 12:00 p.m. 6:30 p.m., Tuesday, of the Fair week.
- 12. Breed Classifications: Durocs, Hampshires, Crosses, Yorks, OPB and Cross (Other Pure Breeds) and must be entered in the on-line registration process.
