- 6. New Lots and Classes may be declared, changed or combined at the discretion of the Superintendent or Judges, to aid in the separation and judging of entries.
- 7. SALES: Any artist wishing to sell artwork during the fair will be given the opportunity to do so. A fee of 20% COMMISSION WILL BE CHARGED FOR SALES MADE AT THE FAIR.
- 8. The Superintendent may at his or her discretion replace any cash prize with a gift certificate of equal or greater value.
- 9. Please be courteous to all Veteran Building volunteers. Without their donation of time, this competition would not be possible!
- 10. Failure to meet or follow any of the above mentioned rules will result in instant disqualification
